EURO-C 2026 continues the series of conferences on **computational methods and numerical models for the analysis of concrete and concrete structures**. EURO-C 2026 will take place on March 9-12, 2026 in Seefeld in Tirol, Austria.

Based upon the success of the first conference and its subsequent amalgamation with the Delft Concrete Mechanics Colloquia, the series of EURO-C conferences continued with venues always located in the Austrian Alps, such as in Zell am See (1990), Innsbruck (1994), Bad Gastein (1998), St. Johann im Pongau (2003), Mayrhofen in Zillertal (2006), Rohrmoos/ Schladming (2010), St. Anton am Arlberg (2014), Bad Hofgastein (2018), and Vienna (2022).

Keeping the spirit of this long-standing tradition, EURO-C 2026 is aiming to bring together researchers and engineers involved in computational modelling of cementitious materials and the model-based design of concrete structures to review and discuss research advancements and to assess the applicability and robustness of methods and models for the analysis and design of concrete, fibre-reinforced and prestressed concrete structures, as well as masonry structures in engineering practice. Recent developments include methods of machine learning, novel discretisation methods, probabilistic models, and consideration of micro-structural aspects in multiscale settings. Overall computational robustness of numerical predictions and mathematical rigour have further increased, implying the need for validation and respective experimental programs.

Distinguished colleagues have agreed to deliver **plenary lectures**, comprising Zdenek Bazant (Northwestern University, USA), Beatrice Belletti (University of Parma, Italy), Gianluca Cusatis (Northwestern University, USA), Max Hendriks (TU Delft, Netherlands), and Günter Hofstetter (University of Innsbruck, Austria).

The scientific programme of EURO-C 2026 will comprise about 110 presentations.
